For everyone to enjoy their holidays in a safe & quiet environment, please adhere to the following rules.

TRAFFIC SPEED Walking pace only at all times, please. This includes bikes, scooters etc and applies to your visitors as well, so please advise them accordingly.

Please remember "children don't bounce": Bikes, scooters, skateboards etc are not permitted after daylight ceases; for safety purposes, bike helmets must be worn.

SITE STICKERS Occupants must display windscreen sticker on vehicle AND site occupation ticket on all caravans or tents.

NOISE Please respect the rights of other guests to peace and quiet. Noise from any source must be kept at a level which does not disturb others at any time, especially after 10pm. Undue noise or objectionable behavior will result in eviction.

THE PROPRIETORS Reserve the right to give one hours notice to leave the camp ground at any time to any person whose conduct is considered objectionable.

CAR PARKING Fees allow for strictly ONE car per site. Visitor's cars are not permitted in the camp ground.

CHECK-IN 12 Noon.

DEPARTURE Please vacate your site by 10am on the day of departure.

LATE DEPARTURE 50% of nightly tariff. Upon request and if available.

REFUNDS Refunds not given.

NO FIRES Due to CFA regulations, no fires, heat beads may be lit at any time.

CHILDREN Must not play in the amenities blocks.

PETS Pets of any description are not permitted.

FISH CLEANING Fish are not to be scaled or cleaned within the camp ground.

LOSS/BREAKAGES Guests must pay the cost of restoring, or making good, any loss or damage caused by them or any person visiting the camp ground at their invitation.

RUBBISH Must be well wrapped before placing in bins. Disposable nappies must be placed in plastic bag.

SITES To be kept tidy at all times, please. No car repairs. Temporary clotheslines must be taken down on departure.

LAUNDRY Washing of clothes under showers or in wash basins prohibited. Washing powder available from Holiday Park reception.

GENERATORS No generators allowed.

BIG4 PARK When camping at the foreshore there is NO access to the BIG4 park facilities.

WET SUITS Are NOT to be worn or washed in showers.

SITE OCCUPATION Management reserves the right to restrict number of persons and cars on any site or in any area of the camp ground. A site allows for 4 adults or a family. Family defined as: Parents and their dependant children. No teenagers to remain on site without parental supervision. Site area to be occupied by one caravan and annexe or two tents.

TRENCHING Trenching around tents and annexes is not permitted.

VISITORS Visitors are asked to check in at BIG4 reception before they enter the camp ground and observe all the rules of the park. Visitor's cars not permitted. Day visitors must pay a fee of \$5.00 per family or \$2.00 per person.

RESPONSIBILITY Management reserves the right to cancel or withdraw any booking made for a person or persons or decline to accept any such booking. The right is reserved to require any guest to withdraw from the camp ground at any time if in the opinion of management or their representatives, his/her acts, conduct or behavior is offensive, detrimental or not compatible with the interests, harmony, comfort or welfare of other guests.

LIABILITY The guest agrees that the occupation and use of the site at the camp ground will be at his own risk and he hereby releases the management and its officers and agents from all liability from any loss or damage to person or property suffered by him or any permitted occupants or any person visiting the camp ground at his or the permitted occupants or his visitors invitation during their stay.

EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURES

In the event that the Foreshore Camping staff direct you to evacuate, immediately turn off gas & power to site, ensure family members/group in immediate area are accounted for, and move to the main assembly area at the Angling Club car park outside the entrance to the park - or move to the beach assembly areas as shown. Upon reaching the beach assembly area please make your way to the Anglers Club assembly area. Refer to the map on this emergency plan to ensure you are clear on the locations of these assembly areas. Please stay calm and await further instructions.

NOTE DO NOT MOVE VEHICLES as it may be difficult for Emergency Services vehicles to access the Foreshore Camping area.
